Pool Rules

Pool hours are: Dawn to Dusk

- The pool is for the use of VILLAGES OF VALENCIA OWNER'S and residents only. AN OWNER OR LESSEE must accompany his/her guests at all times. Trespassers will be prosecuted.
- The pool access card is a security card and cannot be duplicated. It is available from the Association Manager Glen McCutcheon of Leland Management. He can be reached at (904) 263-4060. Only owners or their designees may obtain an access card. Identification will be required when the card is picked up. Cost to replace a lost access card is \$60.00.
- The pool gate must not be opened to anyone not having a card. The card is for the use of the owner or tenant only. Do not loan the card to unauthorized people as doing so may cause your privileges to be revoked.
- The Amenity area is allowed to be used for private parties; however, no reservations are accepted and use will be allowed on a first come first served basis.
- The Pool's capacity is indicated on the signage at the pool. Children under the age of 15 must be accompanied by an adult over the age of 21.
- No running or roughhousing is allowed on the pool deck and no diving or roughhousing is allowed in the pool.
- No glass containers are permitted in the pool area. Beverages may not be consumed in the
 water or on the edge of the pool. No chewing gum is allowed in the pool area. Food
 must be consumed in the amenity area only, which is the area under the roof.
- Absolutely NO ALCHOHOLIC BEVERAGES or SMOKING allowed in the pool or in the amenity area, which is the area under the roof.
- Radios are permitted, but the volume must be kept to a level not to disturb others.
- Small children who are not toilet trained must be diapered before entering the pool. Please
 take any used diapers home with you to dispose of. Please do not dispose of diapers in the
 trash bins.
- Babies, toddlers and non-swimmers using swim aids must have constant supervision.
 Infant floatation devices are permitted under adult supervision.

- You must shower before entering the pool
- Floats, rafts, balls or toys are not permitted in the pool.
- Please do not sit on tabletops or stand children on them for dressing,
- Please throw trash in the trash cans.
- Pool equipment, safety devices and chairs are not toys and are there for everyone's safety. They are not to be played with or thrown in the pool.
- Anyone using foul language or being disorderly will be asked to leave the pool area.
